Temporary Distance Education Course Delivery – Fall 2026

For the **Fall 2026 semester**, the MassBay Community College Radiologic Technology Program will utilize distance education delivery for three professional courses. This is a **temporary modification to course delivery for the Fall 2026 semester** and does not represent a permanent change to the program's traditional instructional format.

Courses Utilizing Distance Education

Course	Delivery Format
RT111 – Radiographic Technique I	Hybrid: Didactic course content will include asynchronous online instruction through Blackboard. Required laboratory experiences and designated instructional activities will continue to be conducted in person.
RT213 – Radiobiology and Radiation Protection	Asynchronous Online: Didactic course content will be delivered online through Blackboard. Opportunities for instructor interaction and scheduled course support will be provided throughout the semester.
RT214 – Radiographic Technique III	Hybrid: Didactic course content will include asynchronous online instruction through Blackboard. Required laboratory experiences and designated instructional activities will continue to be conducted in person.

Technology Requirements

Students participating in courses utilizing distance education must have:

- Access to a computer or laptop capable of accessing MassBay's online learning resources
- Reliable internet access
- A current web browser
- Access to **Blackboard**, MassBay's learning management system
- Access to and regular monitoring of their **MassBay student email account**

Additional Costs

There are **no additional Radiologic Technology program-specific fees associated solely with distance education delivery** of these courses.

Students remain responsible for the usual tuition, fees, textbooks, course materials, and other educational expenses applicable to their enrollment in the Radiologic Technology Program.

Student Participation and Attendance Requirements

Students enrolled in courses utilizing distance education are expected to:

- Regularly access Blackboard and MassBay student email
- Complete assigned online coursework and assessments by established deadlines
- Participate in required course activities
- Attend all required **in-person laboratory sessions, instructional meetings, and clinical education experiences** as scheduled
